## Meeting Feedback

The minutes and paperwork for the SEND Accountability Board and SEND Programme Board are now being uploaded by Suffolk County Council for public access. #### Annual Survey Results

We have now published the results of our Annual Survey. We had a combination of old questions and new ones so there may be some new information on there for you to see. We were encouraged to see that there was an increase in children and young people being involved in their EHCPs. Unfortunately, the lived experience has not improved as we would have hoped in this past year but we will continue fighting for better outcomes.

## A message from Activities Unlimited

If you have completed our new short break personal budget application form and returned the agreement form via the portal once it has been received. We are aiming to make payment between the beginning of April and the end of May 2023.

If you have requested a support telephone application, please bear with us we are working our way through the list of requests and will get to you as soon as possible.

If you receive your personal budget via a prepaid card, please ensure that you have spent your 2022–23 personal budget by the 31st March 2023.

If you receive your personal budget into your own bank account, please ensure you have completed a spending a record and submitted receipts to account for 2022–23.

Regarding the change in your Activities Unlimited Short Break Personal Budget. For the past 3 years Activities Unlimited have been going through a review which we have communicated widely through our website. newsletters. our social media channels and directly via email to current users. We would advise at this stage that you accept your current offer. and we will be able to review all appeals post April. We will be in contact and send an appeal form closer to the time for you to provide us with additional information to support your appeal application. If your appeal is upheld, we will provide an additional top up payment.

# 'Have you tried a sticker chart?' Workshop

Hosted by – Define Fine: Parent Peer Support for Attendance Difficulties

Thursday 4th May from 10:00am to 11:30am

This course focuses on understanding the issues that surround the barriers to school attendance and school distress. Attendance difficulties can be due to a child or young person having SEND – Special Educational Needs and/or Disabilities, physical or mental health issues.

Often in these cases the child is described as being 'fine in school' rather than being assessed and their needs acknowledged.

Define Fine will share their guide based on relevant, current government and statutory guidance and provide a framework for working together and finding solutions. This will help ensure that parent carers are supported and empowered to work with professionals to assess needs, then plan appropriate and timely support for their child or young person.
