- It's also a great way for you and the staff at the doctors to get to know each other.


### What is it?



- An Annual health check is an appointment at your doctors once a year
- These appointments start when you are **14.**
- If you feel well, It's still important to go to your annual health check
- You can go on your own or take someone you trust.

## What checks happen at your annual health check?

At your appointment they will check your...



**blood test** 

- Blood pressure
- Height
- Weight
- Pee
- Ears
- and Listen to your heart They may check some other things too. If you don't like blood tests you don't have to have one just say **no**.

Help with your mental health




• Lifestyle advice ,for example healthy eating
